

DIRECTIONS FOR 2026 STUDIO SCHOLARSHIP SUBMISSION

Please note that our format for Spring 2026 submissions has changed. Please read the following directions carefully.

1. No later than **Wednesday, March 11th at 3pm**, confirm your intention to apply for a scholarship **in person** by contacting Ashley Cheak in the SoFPA office (088 CAC, during the hours of 9am-12pm or 1pm-3pm, M-F). Ashley will collect your information (name, UID#, address, email, etc.) and will provide you with a scholarship form, portfolio identification stickers, and instructions.
2. On **Friday, March 13th** (or the evening before) drop off your portfolio in room 129 CAC by 8:30am. You can leave all your work in the portfolio—just make sure each piece submitted is labeled with your portfolio # sticker.
 - a. 20 works can be submitted, no more than 10 works can be in one medium. DO NOT FOLD YOUR ART WORKS!
 - b. We will only jury work made in WSU studio classes.
 - c. Submit your work in a portfolio- see attached directions.
 - d. MAKE SURE your completed “STUDIO ART CONTINUING STUDENT PORTFOLIO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION” is left with your portfolio. We will collect this form for our records.
3. There are a few select named scholarships we can provide students who specifically wish to pursue a career in arts education (in school or museum settings). If you wish to be eligible for these scholarships, please submit as one-page typed narrative on why you wish to pursue a career in Arts Education along with your scholarship application.
4. You must pick up your portfolio on **Friday, March 13th by 3pm** in room 129 CAC.

FYI: If any work is missing from your portfolio submission, and you are previous scholarship recipient, it has been selected for the Scholarship Exhibition to be held in the Project Space in the Stein Galleries, March 24 – May 2, 2026.
