As a part of your application for admission to the Social Work Department we ask that you write a statement responding to the items listed below. Your statement will be read by members of the Social Work Faculty. It will be assessed for the <u>relevance of content</u> as well as the <u>clarity of expression</u>. Apply the knowledge and experiences you have gained in your social work classes to complete this statement.

You are expected to respond to all of the items. Your statement must be **typed and double-spaced**. Make sure your name is on both the professional statement and social issue paper.

- (1) Students make a decision to pursue a career in social work for a variety of reasons including volunteer and/or work experiences, course work, personal values, and life experiences,. Please develop a <u>500 word statement</u> (about 2 typed, double-spaced pages) discussing your own specific reasons for wanting to become a social worker.
 - Include:
 - Specific strengths you currently have to bring to this professional role.
 - Identify areas of social work practice you need to strengthen before entering practice
 - Specify your hopes for how the social work curriculum will assist you in your professional growth.

Tips for professional statement:

- Stick to the 500 word requirement.
- Address each aforementioned bullet point.
- Be specific you need to support claims that you make with examples from your classroom learning, volunteer experiences, research, etc.
- Information about your personal life story that has influenced your desire to be a social worker should be one paragraph or less.
- Proofread your document your grammar, spelling, sentence structure, and paragraph usage will be evaluated.
- Use 12 point times new roman font.
- Use 1 inch margins.
- Label the top of the paper with the heading 'Professional Statement'.

(2) Discuss a social issue that is of particular interest to you. Prepare a **250 word statement** (about one

typed, double-spaced page) in response. Describe how you believe:

- Our society should address this issue.
- How you might contribute to its resolution.

Tips for social issue paper:

- Stick to the 250 word requirement.
- Address each aforementioned bullet point.
- Be specific you need to support claims that you make with examples from your classroom learning, volunteer experiences, and/or research.
- Proofread your document your grammar, spelling, sentence structure, and paragraph usage will be evaluated.
- Use 12 point times new roman font.
- Use 1 inch margins.
- Label the top of the paper with the heading 'Social Issue'.

WRIGHT STATE UNIVERSITY SOCIAL WORK DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Social Work Department at Wright State University awards several scholarships annually. The scholarships are awarded based on demonstrated financial need and to support the academic performance and career goals of the applicants. Student Professional Development Scholarships are also available to support student presentations at conferences. For further information contact the Raider Connect, (937) 775-4000, or visit their website at wright.edu/raider-connect.

Social Work Scholarship Fund

<u>Supports student development and attendance at scholarly conferences</u>. Students must submit a written request for these funds at least 30 days prior to the academic conference they plan to attend or 30 days before expenses of a research activity. The request should include the scholarly activity and a detailed budget: costs of the conference at the student volunteer rate, costs of sharing a room, costs of sharing transportation, and costs for meals.

Colleen Mercuri-Johnson Scholarship Fund

Supports student internships with persons diagnosed with developmental or intellectual disabilities (DD or ID). One undergraduate and one graduate student will receive a \$500 scholarship for Fall and a \$500 scholarship for Spring semester if they engage in field education with a persons who are DD or ID. Students must discuss their career interest in working with this population.

Richard Blazer Scholarship

<u>Supports students with financial need</u>. Students must describe their specific financial need (e.g. the need to pay for tuition, transportation, or books due to low income or recent loss of job or family obligations) and how this scholarship will help them complete the graduation requirements in social work.

Richard Blazer Fund

<u>Supports MASW students</u>. There is one scholarship available to MASW students who have financial need and have demonstrated academic success.

<u>Supports students pursuing the Gerontology Certificate.</u> There is one scholarship available to an undergraduate or graduate student who will complete the Gerontology Certificate requirements. Demonstrate your interest in pursuing a career working with older adults.

Carl and Karla Brun MSW Service Award

<u>Supports MSW students with volunteer service.</u> Students must have demonstrated financial need; have earned a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale on all previous undergraduate and graduate work; have been accepted into the Masters of Social Work Program; and provide documentation that shows either:

- 1. volunteer service beyond their job or academic requirements, a "pay it forward" spirit to be determined by the Social Work Scholarship Committee or
