The minor in Arabic consists of Arabic language classes totaling 18 credit hours (6 courses) beyond the 1020 level. At least 12 credit hours of the courses required must come from actual classes taken as opposed to credits given for examination or prior learning assessment.

A grade of C or better is required for courses to count toward the minor.

Native or near-native speakers should see their minor advisor for prior learning assessment or course substitutions.
