The International Studies major is designed to offer students the opportunity to undertake serious study in international politics, culture and society. The major combines intensive study of a foreign language with an interdisciplinary curriculum of study chosen by the student in consultation with a faculty advisor. The specialized tracks include:

- B. Area Studies**
- C. Comparative Cultures**
- D. International Economic Affairs**
- E. Global Gender Studies**
- F. Research/Intelligence Analyst**

Students are encouraged to consider spending an optional term or year of university study abroad in their chosen language. This major provides students with a degree relevant to careers in government, international law, business, and organizations, teaching, or related fields.
