Introduction to College Writing introduces you to the activities and expectations of ENG 1100, the first required Wright State Core writing course.

This workshop will help you get ready for your other classes, too: research shows that students who attend the workshop not only earn better grades in ENG 1100 than students who don't; they get better OVERALL grades. Workshop classes will be held in computer classrooms in Millett Hall. You will use the same software used in ENG 1100, which meets in the same computer classrooms.

The workshop fee includes a textbook that you'll probably use in ENG 1100 and 2100 and will be useful in your Intensive Writing courses, too. If you attend all four workshop sessions and do the work, you'll receive a "Commencement" reward: a flash drive and Wright State lanyard.
