



## **COLA 2022-23 OUTSTANDING FACULTY AND STAFF AWARDS**

***SUBMISSION DEADLINE: February 25, 2022***

The Dean's Office of the College of Liberal Arts invites nominations for the 2022-23 Outstanding Faculty and Staff Awards. Awards will be made in the following categories:

### **COLA Outstanding Faculty Member Award - TET**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated TET faculty who have demonstrated a sustained and balanced contribution to the teaching, research, and professional service mission of the university. The award is intended to honor those who serve as the most outstanding role models for faculty. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the appropriate university level award.

### **COLA Outstanding Teaching Award - TET**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated faculty at the rank of associate professor or above, and must have demonstrated outstanding skills as teachers and advisors, as evidenced by student and peer evaluations, course development, and improvement and/or scholarly publications in the area of teaching. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the Robert J. Kegerreis Distinguished Professor of Teaching Award.

### **COLA Outstanding Research Award - TET**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated faculty at the rank of associate professor or above, and must have produced a significant body of work in scholarship, research, or the creative arts, which brings distinction to the University and national or international recognition to the faculty member. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the Brage Golding Distinguished Professor of Research Award.

### **COLA Outstanding Professional Service Award - TET**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated faculty at the rank of associate professor or above, and must have provided exceptional service to the University and the community through outstanding leadership and other significant contributions. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the Frederick White Distinguished Professor of Professional Service Award.

### **COLA Outstanding Faculty Member Award - NTE**

This award recognizes the important contributions of full-time, fully-affiliated, non-tenure track faculty. Nominees must have demonstrated excellence in teaching, university service and professional development. The award is intended to honor those who serve as the most outstanding role models for NTE faculty.

**COLA Outstanding Service Award - NTE**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated non-tenure track faculty. Nominees must have demonstrated excellence in service while successfully contributing to all aspects of faculty responsibility. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the appropriate university level award.

**COLA Outstanding Teaching - NTE**

Nominees must be full-time, fully-affiliated non-tenure track faculty. Nominees must have demonstrated excellence in teaching while successfully contributing to all aspects of faculty responsibility. The recipient of this award will be the college's nominee for the appropriate university level award.

**COLA Outstanding Adjunct Award**

This award recognizes the important contributions of adjunct faculty, including CCPlus faculty, to the teaching mission of the college and university. Nominees must have demonstrated excellence in teaching and in engaging students.

**COLA Outstanding Staff Award**

This award recognizes the important contributions of staff in carrying out the mission and goals of the college and university. Nominees must be full-time staff within the college, and have demonstrated excellence in their position. Nominators are strongly encouraged to submit these nominations to the Presidential Awards for Excellence.

**Process**

Anyone may submit a nomination. Recipients must be WSU employees during the 2022-23 academic year. Awards will be chosen by the CoLA Promotion and Tenure Committee.

Nominations should include:

- A completed nomination form
- A two-page letter of nomination summarizing nominee accomplishments
- A copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae or resume, with particular emphasis on the criteria for which they are being nominated
