WSU offers an undergraduate program which will enable you to be licensed to teach (K-12 French or Spanish) after completing your B.A. in French or Spanish. The following courses are pre-requisites for students planning to complete the licensure program.

ED 2600 “Intro to Education” - 3 credit hours

ED 2650 “Field Experience I” – 1 credit hour*

ED 2700 “Educational Psychology” – 3 credit hours

ED 2750 “Field Experience II” – 1 credit hour*

EDS 2900 “Exceptionalities” – 3 credit hours
