Kristina Wassmann, MAT, explains her German Activism

"As a German teacher with Centerville School District for seventeen years, I have been the school's German club advisor for the duration of my tenure with the school. During the seventeen years, I have spent ten years as the GAPP exchange coordinator with Centerville's Sister City of Bad Zwischenahn, Germany. Cross-cultural connections between approximately 150 students were fostered during the three-week long exchanges between our two countries. Countless friendships between Germany and the USA blossomed and many of our participants are still in contact with each other, having attended each other's weddings or other life events. I have been an AP teacher for the entire duration of my employment with Centerville City schools and have helped countless students score high marks on the AP test, which earned them thousands in dollars of college credit for German.

Many students went on to pursue degrees with German majors and minors; with some of my students studying in Germany or Austria and some even re-locating to Germany or Austria.

My impact on the lower levels also includes having been a teacher for all levels at Centerville High School. I guided students from their humble beginnings to winning Gold medal honors at the AATG National German Exam, celebrating their success with a culminating awards ceremony to highlight their German talents but also to give all students a platform to showcase musical talents as well.

Having been president of the Association of American German teachers (AATG) from 2011-2014 afforded me the opportunity to closely work together with a college professor to craft tailor-made
